

We are indeed challenged here in California compared to the East Coast for instance, to see some of the more spectacular changes! It means we must look a little harder.

There is a street near our home that is beautiful! I will deliberately drive that street home just to see the changing colors! A deliberate action. I purposefully change the pattern of my driving to see the fall colors.

I wonder to myself, if I'm willing to change my habits and patterns to see the Fall colors, what other areas in my life are inviting me to deliberate action? One area I think of immediately is Gratitude. Here we are in the month of Thanksgiving. I wonder if I can put some deliberate action into practice this month. One idea would be at the end of the day, I review the day and give deliberate gratitude for every hour of the day. Even those moments that are difficult, trying, a little confusing, overwhelming and just obnoxious! What if I made deliberate action especially for those moments to give gratitude to God, to others, for that time?

Deliberate action needs to be practiced. It is conscious choices to make priorities and decide what is important to us. Deliberate action not only is practiced but is prayed. It may be a little uncomfortable as we earnestly pray about "who needs my time?", "who needs my money?", "who needs a listening ear, a prayer, a compassionate understanding?"

Gratitude is returning to God our thanks for all that God has given us. We give ourselves to others as an expression of Gratitude and loving God. Is there a deliberate action that God is inviting in your life this season?
